Commissioner Gifford made a motion to pay all bills that are before the board at this time. Commissioner Dowling second, roll call vote, full board yes.

89 yes, Scollay=yes, Dowling -yes, Horn-abstained, passed.

93 1 - Commissioner Dowling said the cleaning crew said they need  
94 supplies. A discussion followed.  
95 2 - Commissioner Gifford made a motion to purchase 5 sets of  
96 turn out gear for \$12,477.25. Second by Commissioner Horn, roll  
97 call vote yes.  
98 3 - Commissioner Gifford made a motion to purchase 600 ft. of  
99 5in. yellow hose at \$3,432.00, one 100ft of 5in red hose at  
100 \$572.00, 1-10ft 1¾ hose at \$60.00 for a total of \$4,064.00.  
101 Second by Commissioner Scollay, roll call vote yes.  
102 4 - Commissioner Gifford made a motion to have Copper Power  
103 Systems up to \$660.00 to trouble shot the standby generator in  
104 the new station. Second by Commissioner Scollay, roll call vote  
105 yes.  
106 5 - Commissioner Gifford made a motion to buy new uniforms for  
107 first aid for \$1,470.00. Second by Commissioner Dowling, roll  
108 call vote yes.  
109 6 - Commissioner Scollay commented that the fire company did a  
110 professional job at the Ocean Grove fire.  
111 7 - Commissioner Scollay made a resolution to dispose of all the  
112 hose that failed during the hose testing. 21-lengths of  
113 5in.hose, 4-lengths of 1 ¾ hose, 2-lengths of 3in.hose, 1 length  
114 of 2 ½ hose that are no longer serviceable. Second by  
115 Commissioner Dowling, roll call vote-yes.  
116 8 - Commissioner Horn made a motion to let Mike Evans use 37-2-  
117 99 on April 29 & 30, 2019 to go to The Emergency Management  
118 Conference in Atlantic City. Second by Commissioner Dowling,  
119 roll call vote, no.  
120 9 - Commissioner Horn mad a resolution to dispose of equipment  
121 that is no longer need by the fire district. The equipment is 25  
122 Steamlight hand lights, 1- Streethawk light bar, and 2- negative  
123 pressure electric fans. Second by Commissioner Gifford, roll  
124 call vote yes.
