**Resolution Authorizing the Award of a Non Fair and Open Contract
For Accounting Services**

WHEREAS, the Fire District has a need to acquire accounting services as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

WHEREAS, the Fire District has determined and certified in writing that the value of the acquisition will exceed \$17,500; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated term of this contract is for the year 2018-2019; and

WHEREAS, Koerner & Korner, P.A. has submitted a proposal indicating it will provide accounting services pursuant to the proposal; and

WHEREAS, Koerner & Korner, P.A. has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that it has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit it from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Fire District has determined that funds are available concerning the projected expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2 in the Township of Ocean, County of Monmouth, authorized the Fire District to enter into a contract with Koerner & Korner, P.A. as described herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Determination of Value be placed with this resolution.
